Fast Facts

5,700 Neighbors Being Served Each Month

- In fiscal year 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed over 2 million pounds of food.
- This equates to approximately 529,000 meals for those in need.
- The Food Bank distributed 294,000 pounds of fresh produce during fiscal year 2017-18.
- 94% of every dollar goes to food and programs.
- Since 2014 overall distribution for the Food Bank has increased 87%.
