


2018-2019 ANNUAL REPORT

Client Profile

Elk Grove Food Bank currently provides emergency food, clothing, and social support assistance to over **6,000** individuals monthly. Our clients are residents of Elk Grove (zip codes: 95624, 95757, 95758) and adjacent areas (zip codes: 95828, 95829, 95683, 95759). They include low-income families, seniors, children, veterans, disabled and the homeless.

Clients by Age Group




Programs

Emergency Food Distribution

Last year, Elk Grove Food Bank provided emergency food assistance to an average of 5,500 individuals monthly. Roughly 53% of food assistance is distributed to clients who come to our warehouse, and 42% is distributed remotely at 8 different “mobile pantry” locations. Our senior mobile distribution and wellness home delivery programs provide nutritional packages to elderly and medically fragile individuals.

Clothes Closet

Elk Grove Food Bank provided new and refurbished clothing to over **16,200** individuals last year. They included students, persons entering or seeking to enter the workforce, and homeless.

Support Works is a comprehensive and coordinated program to assist individuals in their effort to work toward self-sufficiency. Last year 534 clients were assisted in areas such as locating housing and developing interview and job skills.


The Kay Foundation Veteran’s Assistance Program provides case management, food, clothing and other assistance to homeless and low-income former members of our nation’s military.


Finances
